# 11. Lassen Mt Soledad Plaque - Mounted



## LT Clyde E. Lassen, USN Medal of Honor

LTJG Clyde Lassen was presented the Medal of Honor for conspicuous gallantry at the risk of his life above and beyond the call of duty as the pilot of a search and rescue helicopter during operations against enemy forces in North Vietnam. LTJG Lassen skillfully piloted his aircraft and directed his crew over unknown and hostile terrain under enemy fire to rescue a downed F-4J fighter crew. LTJG Lassen directed his aircraft and crew on numerous approaches through intense enemy fire in total darkness including collision with a tree and turning his landing lights on to affect the recovery of LCDR John Holtzclaw and LCDR John Burns who were being pursued by enemy forces from a jungle hillside. LT Lassen's crew, LTJG LeRoy Cook, AE2 Bruce Dallas and ADJ3 Don West, courageously provided aircraft clearance, systems backup, and hands-on personnel recovery while simultaneously furnishing covering fire to keep the enemy in close proximity at bay. LTJG Lassen then flew while dangerously low on fuel and under continued enemy fire to return aircraft, crew and rescued aviators safely to an offshore destroyer.

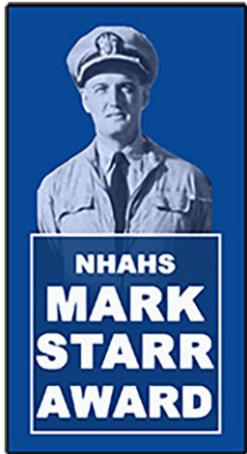

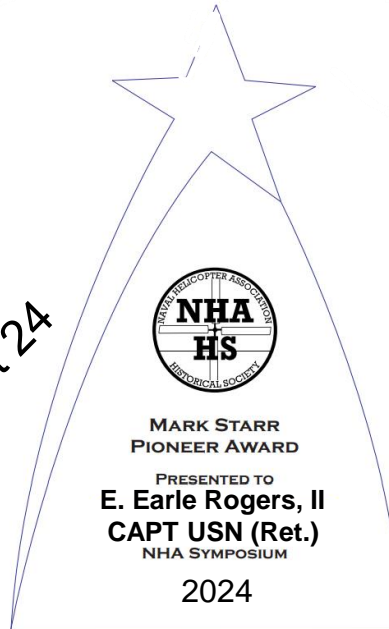

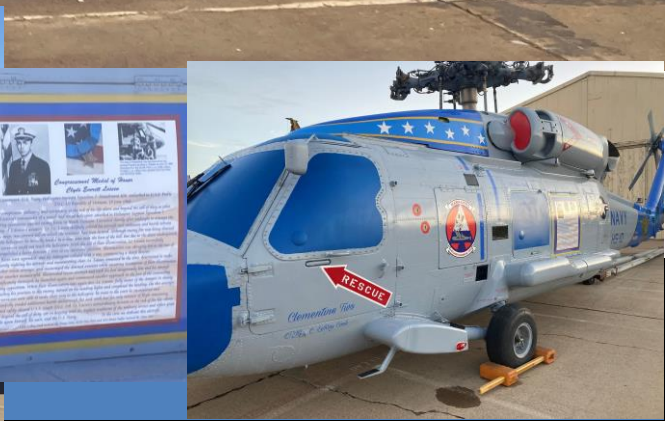
